It is our endeavor and zeal to skill the students according to the requirement and demand of the market so that the brand of MBA (FM) does not get diluted.



The recently concluded third edition of 'Make In Odisha Conclave' brought in investment proposals of Rs. 10.5 trillion, topping the previous sums by a big margin. This speaks volumes. it gives us all in Odisha a sense of prestige and pride, to host for the second time, the Odisha Hockey Men's World Cup 2023. Apart from our industrial capability, it is sports that has put us on the global map To be entrusted to host significant sporting events provides a state with large intangible benefits. Odisha has previously hosted other large sporting events - the Asian Athletic Championship and the FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup. Odisha has introduced shuttle fliahts between Bhubaneswar and Rourkela for passengers flying to attend the ongoing Odisha Hockey Men's World Cup. Businesses can take advantage of the booming market in the local economy, especially in the steel, iron, and cement sectors. Odisha also hosted the Dot Fest, which includes a flea market/night bazaar, photo exhibition - 'Sebbe o Ebbe' - to showcase the photographs of Bhubaneswar from the late 1860s to 2023, an international food festival comprising cuisines of the 16 participating nations in the world cup, trails around the capital city, and a storytelling festival - Bhu-festo.





BHUBANESWAR

The word Bhubaneswar in its literal sense means the 'Gods World' which showcases the centuries old temple architecture. The temple city of Bhubaneswar eastern India is also located in known Mandiramalini, Ekamra Kshetra and Kalinga Nagari. With 500 temples in its treasure, the city is probably the only city in the world that presents a veritable overview of the stages of development of Hindu religious architecture. Today these temples are a gentle reminder of the glorious past and the rich heritage of India. It is an administrative, information technology, education and tourism city. The city is one of the fastest developing cities in India and has played its part in the development of Odisha, which is realizing the potential of its abundant natural resources and skilled manpower. As many big players have already set up their operations in Bhubaneswar, Bhubaneswar is becoming a favourite destination for many IT & ITES companies. Bhubaneswar's IT sector is finally beginning to change for the better It is emerging as an IT hub, with organizations like Infosys, TCS, Wipro, Mindfire solutions, CSM technologies, Mind tree Limited, Deloitte, Mahindra Satyam and many more setting up offices here. Bhubaneswar has found a place in the Central Government's Smart City Project which promises huge potential for further growth.



Utkal University, established in the year of 1943, is the 17th oldest university in India. Its present campus at Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar is located on a sprawling 400 acres in the heart of the city. The foundation stone of the campus was led by Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first president of India in 1958 and the campus was inaugurated by Dr. S Radhakrishnan, the second president of India in 1963. It has the largest academic campus in Odisha thus the state's largest in this respect. There are in present 27 Post graduated departments located in the university campus for studies & research in various disciplines of science, humanities, business administration, social science, law & commerce. There are at least 15 self- financing sponsored courses including the MBA(Financial Management) formerly known as MFC programme.




PEDAGOGY

CENTER OF INCUBATION

PARIJA LIBRARY



The central library of Utkal University, named after its first Vice Chancellor, Professor Pranakrushna Parija, is one of the finest libraries in the state of Odisha. Set up in 1946 in Cuttack, it was shifted to the campus of Utkal University in Bhubaneswar in1962. The building of the library, an impressive edifice, is spread over 28,000 square foot and comprises large reading rooms, periodical, reference, manuscript, documentation and text-book and administrative sections. The holdings of the library consist of more than two Lakhs of books and 5800 rare manuscripts. To serve the information needs of its large number of users in a globalised world the library, as part of INFLIBNET e-ShodhSindhu Consortium and OSHEC Consortium provides them access to wide variety of e-resources. The faculty, students, research scholars and employees of the University find Parija Library a vibrant and welcoming learning space.



DEPARTMENT LIBRARY



The Dept Library has a well-equipped facility for reading, to meet the informational needs and intellectual pursuit of the students. In consultation with the head of the department, it has been designed and co-ordinated as there are rules, regulations and functioning of the department library. 





